Themed Weeks

(July 6th – September 3rd)

Proud to be an American (July 6th -9th) – Campers will learn all about what makes our nation great. We will discuss and explore various national landmarks, historical events and the history of our flag. The week will end with a themed “Red, White & Blue” Party!

Under The Sea (July 12th – 16th) – This week focuses on all things wet and wild! From deep sea creatures and plant life, beach safety and how to help keep our waterways clean, your camper will be a fully immersed in this week’s curriculum.

Sports Week (July 19th-23rd) – During Sports Week, our students learn about teamwork and rules in various sport activities. Volleyball, baseball, and kickball games will be played as well as potato sack races and field hockey!

Winter in July (July 26th-30th) – Surprise, it’s winter in July! Our campers will be making their own snow, discussing the Artic Tundra and celebrating the winter holidays around the world this week. Iced chocolate anyone?

Weird Science Week (August 2nd- 6th) - We’ll make a wacky little scientist out of your child this week. The week is filled with experiments such as making erupting volcanoes, growing rock crystals and recording chemical reactions!

Adventure Week (August 9th- 13th) – Your camper will go on “Safari” and explore jungles, rainforests and deserts. They will also learn all about the unusual animals that inhabit these areas.

Fun With Food Week (August 16th-20th) – Your camper will look dapper in a chef’s hat as they cook up a variety of foods. Various countries and cultures will be introduced and how they use foods to celebrate their heritage. Each day ends with a party to sample the cuisine.

Olympic Games Week (August 23rd-27th) – During Olympic Week, Ancient Greece will be explored as the scene of the first Olympic games. Each day will also include games for the children to participate in from sprinting races to “ice-skater” races. Everyone’s a winner during Olympic week.

History Week (August 30th – September 3rd) – Various time periods will be visited this week.
