## Camp Kaleidoscope

### Turrell Child Care & Early Learning Center's Summer Camp Program

The Turrell Center is offering Camp Kaleidoscope for children ages 5 through 9, from July 5 through September 3. It features a theme-based curriculum that is designed to reinforce and strengthen school concepts while providing a fun and memorable summer experience for your child.

Campers will explore the universe during Space Week, "visit" Egypt and Rome via the interactive SMART Board during Archeology Week, learn ways to help others during Community Week, learn about the wonders of the sea during Ocean Reef Week, and compete in their own Olympic Games during Athletic Week. Additionally, campers will enjoy cooking activities, music and movement, arts and crafts and shows and games in a safe environment, led by a certified teacher. The children will also spend time outside, enjoying the playground and having fun engaging in water play.

Additionally, an optional Reading Assistance Program is available, where a certified teacher will work one-on-one with your child for 30 minutes a day to help improve reading skills. The fee for this program is not included in the camp tuition rate. Please ask about it when you register your child.
